Please accept this proposal to institute Boys and Girls Cross Country as a new sport at NB Middle School for the upcoming 2017-2018 school year.

There are several reasons behind making this proposal to add a sport at this particular time. The main purpose in developing this program is due to the current growth of the Mid-Northern Conference in which NBMS is a member. We recently added two new schools to the conference this past year which now puts us at 10 schools. Currently, 6 of the member schools (Harvard, Marengo, Genoa Kingston, Westminster, Fox River Grove and Prairie Grove) have a cross country team which now makes it an official conference sport. I have listed a few other reasons below as to why I believe this would be a good addition.

- Startup costs would be minimal. We already have track uniforms which would be used for Cross Country. We already have a host site at NB High School and we can utilize their site for no charge. Transportation charges would be minimal as we would only be adding approximately 5-6 additional trips as several meets would be in conjunction with high school meets where we would probably only use one bus (based on numbers). Entry fees for Cross Country are fairly minimal compared to other sports since there is very little overhead and meet officials and worker expenses are just a fraction of what other sports demand.
- I have talked with some students on the possible interest of having a cross country team and I believe we should have a program that will continue to grow over the years.
- I have already reached out to several other local schools and we would have several viable invitational meets available to us for this upcoming year if we chose to compete, so scheduling would not be an issue.
- I don't believe that our current football, soccer or volleyball programs would suffer greatly, if at all, by adding this sport in the same season.

With the current growth of the Cross Country program at NB High School, I think this would serve as a great feeder system into that program.
