### Summer Library Program

**Purpose-** To give students an opportunity to continue their positive reading momentum throughout the summer by having both libraries open as well as Books on Wheels where we will deliver the libraries to the students

**Which students will be served?-** All district students will be served by having the Capron and Poplar Grove libraries opened twice a week. The Books on Wheels bus will travel to low income areas of our school district including the Capron and Poplar Grove Trailer Parks.

**What are the hours and locations?**

**When and where will the Books on Wheels bus be located?** The Books on Wheels bus will be driven on **Tuesdays from 1 pm – 5 pm.** They will be driven the same dates listed above on Tuesday. This bus will make four stops:

1. Poplar Grove Trailer Park
2. Candlewick Lake
3. Capron Trailer Park
4. Lions Park- Capron

**What is the cost of this summer reading program?** We will use a total of about **147** hours of librarian staff (see below). This equates to around \$3822 for salaries and about \$200 for materials which equals **\$4022.**
